These instructions will help you to fully enjoy your new automatic watch.



Never forget to <u>completely screw down</u>
<u>the crown</u> after setting the time or the date
in order to maintain the watch's water resistance.
Push the crown towards the case, then,
while maintaining pressure, screw it
in a clockwise direction

After any contact with salt water it is advisable to rinse your watch in clear water and dry it with a soft cloth.


HAND-WINDING



Your watch is automatic and winds itself thanks to the movements of your wrist. However, it is sometimes necessary to wind it manually if you haven't used it for a while.

- 1 Fully unscrew the crown, turning anti-clockwise.
- 2 When the crown is fully unscrewed, turn it 20 to 30 times in a clockwise direction to wind the movement.

SETTING THE DATE AND THE TIME



- To set the date, unscrew the crown then pull it out one click to position (A).
- Turn the crown in a clockwise direction to set the date.

 Avoid setting the date when the time is showing between 11:00 and 1:00, because it could damage the mechanism.
- To set the time, unscrew the crown then pull it out two clicks to position ${\color{red} {\tt B}}.$

Turn the crown to set the time.

ROTATING BEZEL



Your watch is fitted with an unidirectional diving bezel. It allows you to calculate the immersion time during scuba diving.

- $\boldsymbol{\cdot}$ The bezel is designed to only turn anti-clockwise.
- Place the mark (small triangle) on the departure time (to calculate a duration) or on arrival time (to respect a time).
